LLM Implications



LLMs have tremendous potential to empower communities and democratize knowledge. But given the concentrated development landscape and the datasets on which they are based, LLMs are unlikely to achieve these goals.

IMPLICATIONS OF LLM DEVELOPMENT

LLMs WILL EXACERBATE ENVIRONMENTAL INJUSTICE

LLM processing occurs in physical data centers, which require massive amounts of natural resources. Data center construction is already disproportionately harming marginalized populations.

THE THIRST FOR DATA

To operate properly, LLMs consume enormous amounts of data. This will challenge traditional ideas of individual informed consent and create incentives for unethical data extraction and use.

LLMs WILL BE DEPLOYED INITIALLY AS ASSISTIVE

To gain social acceptance, developers will initially introduce LLMs into large, authoritative systems. They will also emphasize the technology's modularity and capacity to empower users.

4 LLMs WILL REINFORCE INEQUALITY

Neither the development landscape nor LLM datasets represent marginalized communities adequately. As a result, we expect LLMs to systematically minimize and misrepresent these voices while amplifying the perspectives of the already powerful.

D LLMS WILL REMAKE LABOR AND EXPERTISE

LLMs will transform, rather than replace, many occupations. Humans will shift to more complex and risky tasks, and many workers and consumers will resist these technologies.
